

NON-PRO RANCH AND RANCH CLASS RULES

CCCHA RULES FOR *NON-PRO RANCH CLASS* EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1ST, 2009

These rules pertain only to the Non-Pro Ranch

- Rules are as any other class except rider will not be deducted points for reining their horse.
- You must own the horse.
- Horse can not have more than \$2000.00 in NCHA earnings.
- Riders can not have any NCHA earnings.
- Non-Pro Class Champion (horse only) at the year end will not be eligible to compete in this class in the future.

CCCHA RULES FOR *RANCH CLASS* EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1ST, 2009

These rules pertain only to the Ranch Class, not the Non-Pro Ranch

- Rules are as any other class except rider will not be deducted points for reining their horse.
- \$2000.00 limit on horse and/or rider in any judged cattle event (Club money included).
- Rider does not have to own horse shown.
- Rider can enter as many horses as they like.
- Points will follow the horse. (No switching points).
- For Year-end points, rider must ride the same horse through the year.
- Re-run cattle. Four head of cattle per entry. Class will use cattle run in the previous class.
- Ranch Class Champion (horse only) at the year end will not be eligible to compete in this class in the future.
